The VMCLI Internal Medicine Team in conjunction with our comprehensive Critical Care Department will now be providing hemodialysis services starting in January of 2025. In veterinary medicine, acute kidney injury is the primary indication for hemodialysis. Other conditions include hyperkalemia, fluid overload, and oliguria/anuria and to provide an excretory boost with chronic kidney failure. While the types of conditions are readily evident, the initiation of dialysis for acute kidney injury early in the process leads to far better outcomes.

Hemodialysis Services Available at the Veterinary Medical Center of Long Island:

- Acute kidney injury
- Hyperkalemia
- Oliguria/anuria
- Fluid overload
- **Acute Poisoning**
- Severe acid-base disturbances
- Refractory acute renal failure
